# Fairview Baptist Church Golf Tournament Bogey Package \$25

#### Free Throw

Each <u>TEAM</u> is allowed one (1) free throw from anywhere on the golf course (rough, fairway, hazard, green) and is treated as a continuation of the last shot. The free throw <u>CANNOT</u> be used to compete on prize holes.

Examples of when to use the free throw:

- a) If the approach shot is short of the green the free throw can be used to get on the green or maybe in the hole!
- b) to get out of a hazard
- c) to finish out a putt that just missed.

### String

Each <u>TEAM</u> is given 6 feet of string. The string is used as a continuation of the putt on the green. The string <u>CANNOT</u> be used to compete on prize holes.

Example of how to use the string:

\* If the putt misses, the string is measured from the ball to the edge of the cup and cut off. The putt is now assumed to have gone in. Any remaining string may be used on other holes until depleted.

## Mulligan

Each <u>TEAM</u> is allowed one Mulligan. A Mulligan is a do-over or repeat of the last shot without penalty. The Mulligan <u>CANNOT</u> be used to compete on prize holes.

#### **Ladies Tee**

Each <u>TEAM</u> is allowed one use of the Ladies Tee. The Ladies Tee <u>CANNOT</u> be used to compete on prize holes.

Example of how to use the Ladies Tee:

- a) On a par 3, the player can use a lower club for more control and accuracy
- b) On a par 4, the drive may reach the green
- c) On a par 5, the green is reachable in 2 stokes

All items may be used individually or in combination.

Each team may purchase a (only one) Bogey Package for \$25.

Each individual player may purchase an additional Bogey Item (only one) for \$10.
